EMS Meeting Point	Main Entrance Gate off Mersea Road 12
AED Location	Field House / Clubhouse Main Lobby
Nearest Hospital	Erie Shores HealthCare 194 Talbot St W, Leamington, ON N8H 1N9

### ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Charge Person	Assesses injury, manages scene, stays with victim. (Usually Coach/Club Official)
Call Person	Calls 911, provides address, and meets EMS at Meeting Point.
Safety Person	Controls crowd/players, brings First Aid Kit & AED to scene.

### EMERGENCY PROTOCOL

- **Step 1:** Charge Person assesses scene safety and victim's ABCs (Airway, Breathing, Circulation).
- **Step 2:** Call Person dials 911. State: 1) Nature of emergency, 2) Address, 3) Meeting Point, 4) Current status of victim.
- **Step 3:** Call Person goes to Main Entrance Gate off Mersea Road 12 to signal and guide emergency vehicles.
- **Step 4:** Safety Person clears the area of other participants and provides First Aid/AED if necessary.
- **Step 5:** Charge Person remains with victim until EMS arrives. Complete Injury Report afterward.

### WEATHER POLICY (Ontario Soccer)

**Lightning:** If thunder is heard or lightning seen, evacuate fields immediately. **Wait 30 minutes** after the last sound of thunder before resuming activity.

**Site Notes:** Ensure you specify the Field Number to dispatch (e.g., 'Field 3') as this is a 54-acre complex.
